Ashes Scattering Service

Coast Guard Mooloolaba offers Ashes Scattering at sea as a community service, using our 13.8 metre vessel “Mooloolaba Rotary Rescue”.

This service can be arranged for any day of the week. Service details are as follows:

- Up to 8 visitors (including Chaplain) can be accommodated on Mooloolaba Rotary Rescue”.
- An extra 4 can be accommodated on our smaller vessel “Rotary III”, if required.



- You can use the QF6 Chaplain, your own Chaplain, or use your own words.
- An Order of Service is provided, showing the exact location of the ceremony.

- The normal location is off Alexandra Headland however, other sites can be arranged.
- The length of the voyage/service is typically one hour to Alexandra Headland.
- You need to be able to board the boat without assistance and wear enclosed footwear.
